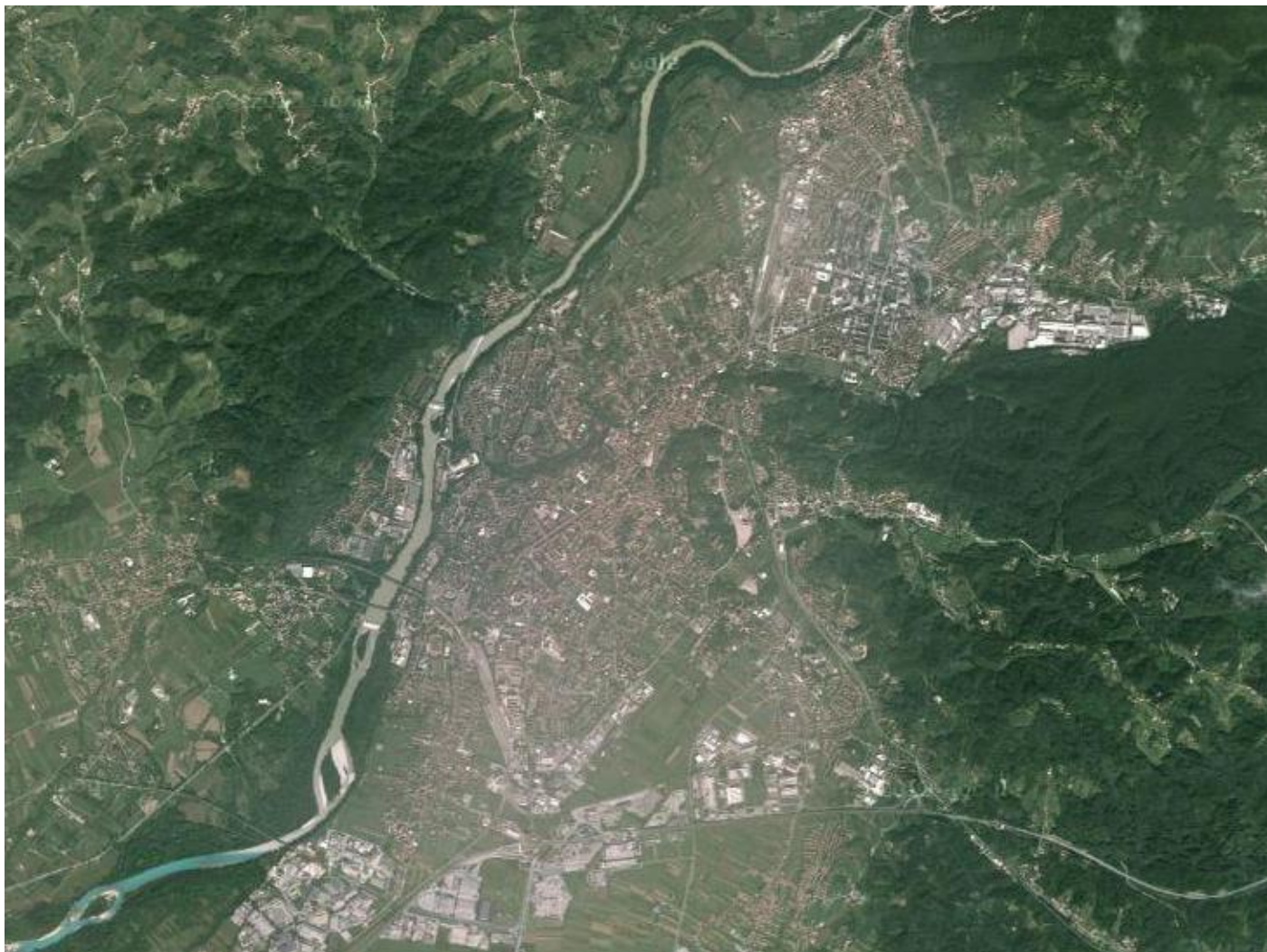

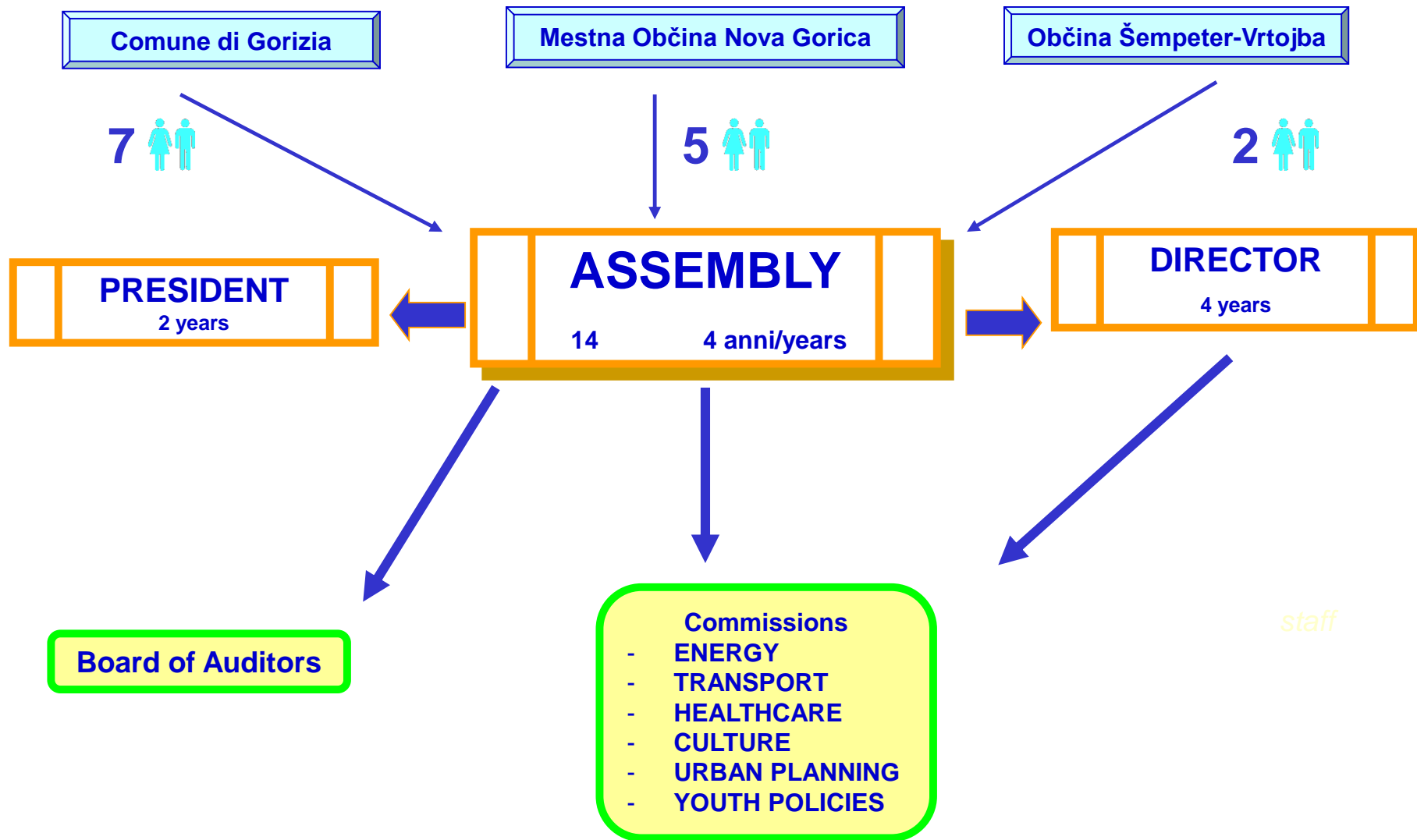

A STRATEGIC PLAN for the Integrated development of economic and infrastructure resources and common services in EGTC GO area

To launch new economic perspectives in a period of severe crisis thanks to transport & logistic

To guarantee basic health services to the population of the tree cities (starting from territorial services in motherhood)

To invest in our common heritage (Isonzo Soča River) in view of the Centenary of the first world war celebration

HOW TO IMPLEMENT EGTC GO STRATEGIC PLAN?

INTEGRATED TERRITORIAL INVESTMENT: the new «delivery mechanism» of a territorial strategy

(Reg. (UE) n. 1303/2013 art. 36 - Reg. (UE) n. 1299/13 art. 11)

Focus on territorial impact of EU policy – more local or ‘place-based’ form of policy making

Be drawn from at least two different priorities axes of one or more OPs

Flexible mechanism to respond to territorial needs

ITI KEY ELEMENTS

An identified territory and a connected integrated development territorial strategy

EGTC GO Area (Gorizia Nova Gorica Šempeter Vrtojba)

Defined pilot actions ready to implement


Cross Border Natural Park
Network of cross-border Health Services
Cross border logistic platform

Governance arrangement to manage the ITI

EGTC GO as Sole Beneficiary and Intermediate body with separate functions

MID-TERM RESULTS

 **LEVERAGE EFFECT OF STRUCTURAL FUNDS: 8,5 MILLIONS ERDF ITI + OVER 2 MILLIONS FROM HEALTH BODIES INVOLVED IN THE PROJECT FOR COMMON INFRASTRUCTURES**

 **SOLVED MANY TECHNICAL PROBLEMS SUCH AS DIFFERENCES ON: MEDICAL PROFESSIONS, HEALTH INSURANCE, DIFFERENT CLINICAL APPROACHES, CROSS-BORDER INFRASTRUCTURAL WORKS APPLYING DIRECTIVE EU 24/2014**

 **MULTILEVEL GOVERNANCE: INVOLVEMENT OF REGIONAL LEVEL/STATE LEVEL IN BOTH MS TO SOLVE CROSS-BORDER OBSTACLE SUCH AS MOBILITY OF PATIENTS**
