

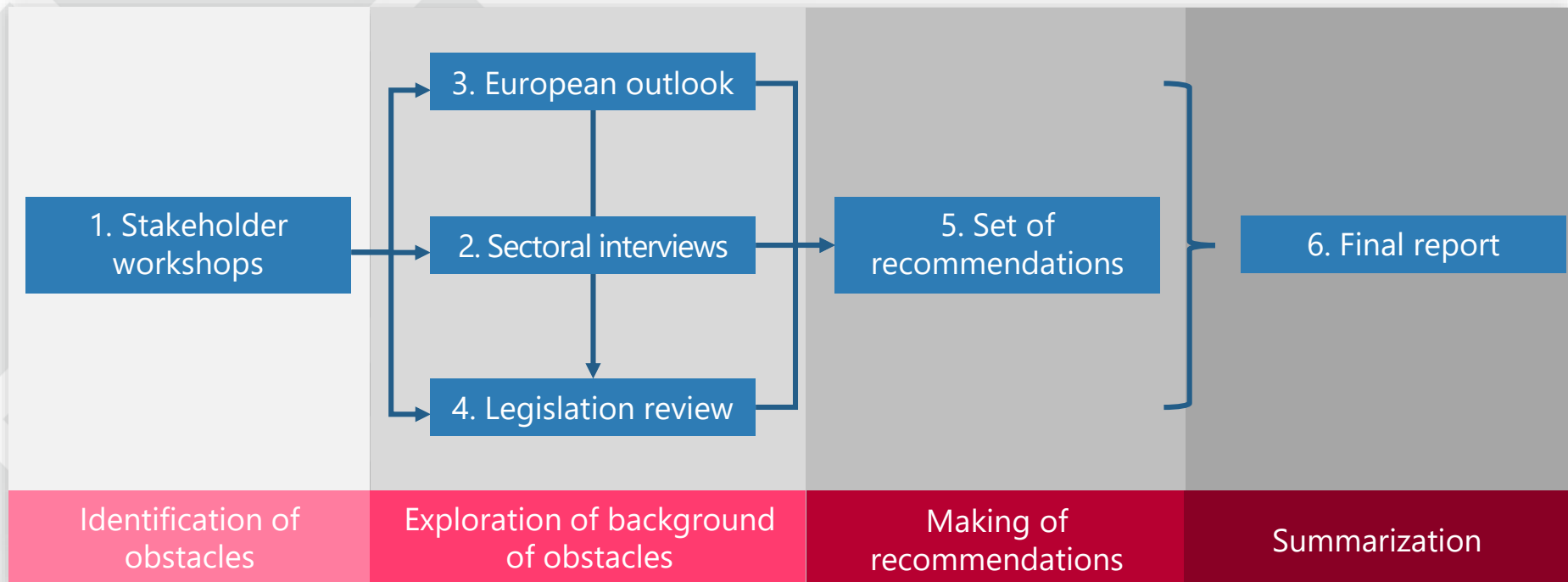

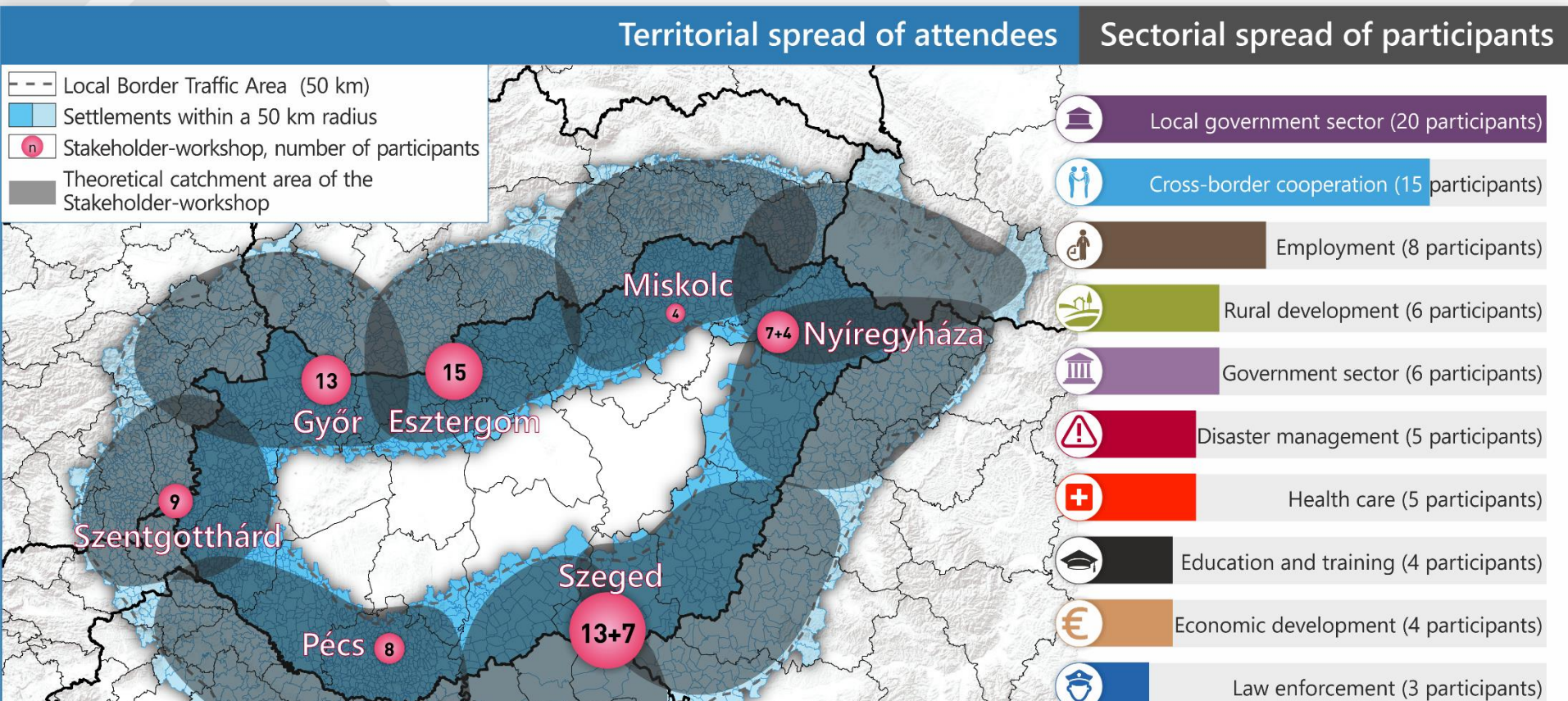

- Study and platform (e-DEN) on cross-border obstacles developed by the Council of Europe (2014)
- Freedom of Movement Council of the Nordic Council of Ministers (2014)
- Cross-Border Review project (2015)
- Luxembourg Presidency – ECBM proposal (2015)
- Communication *,Boosting Growth and Cohesion in EU Border Regions'* (2017)

- Pilot project (January – October 2016)
- Supported by the Hungarian Ministry of Justice
- 10 stakeholder workshops: 57 obstacles
- 52 European good examples (EDEN, MOT, AEBR)
- 68 interviews in total



- Analysis of nearly 250 legislations
- 39 concrete policy or legal recommendations
- 2 horizontal recommendations: access to information + **permanent mechanisms**

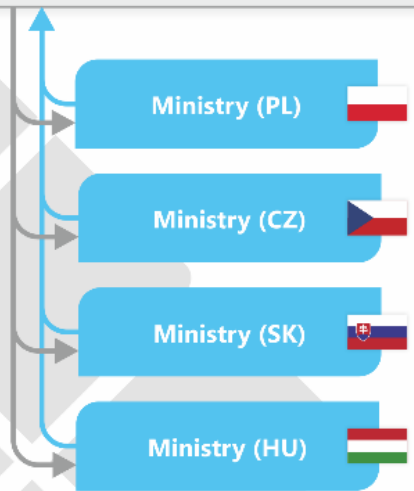
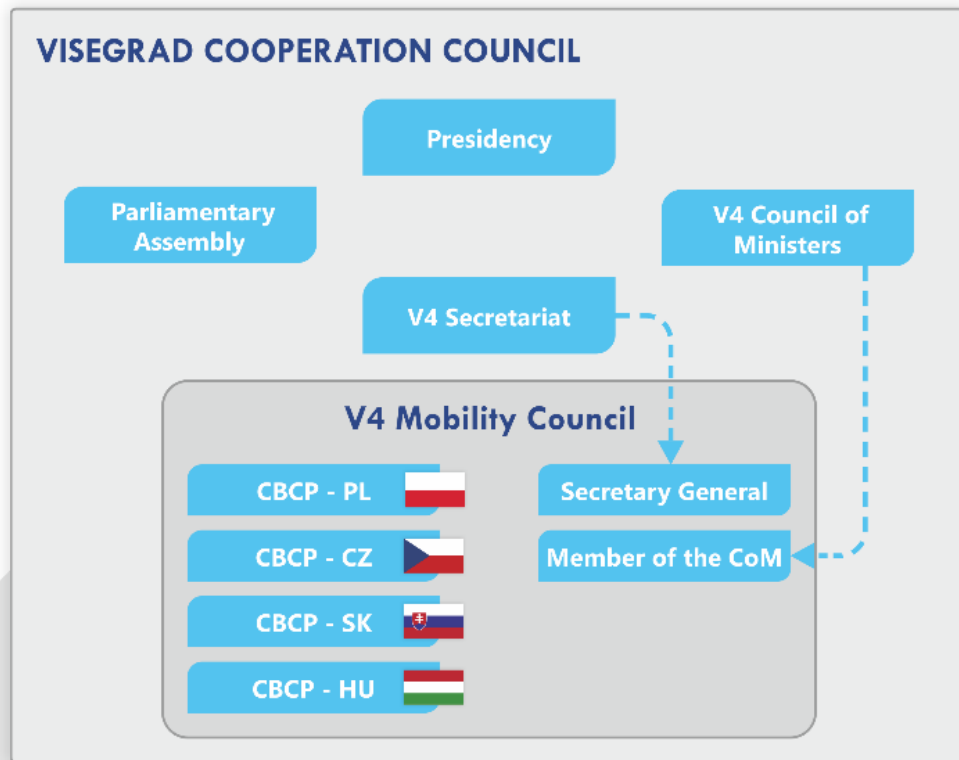
The result: a three-layered model
