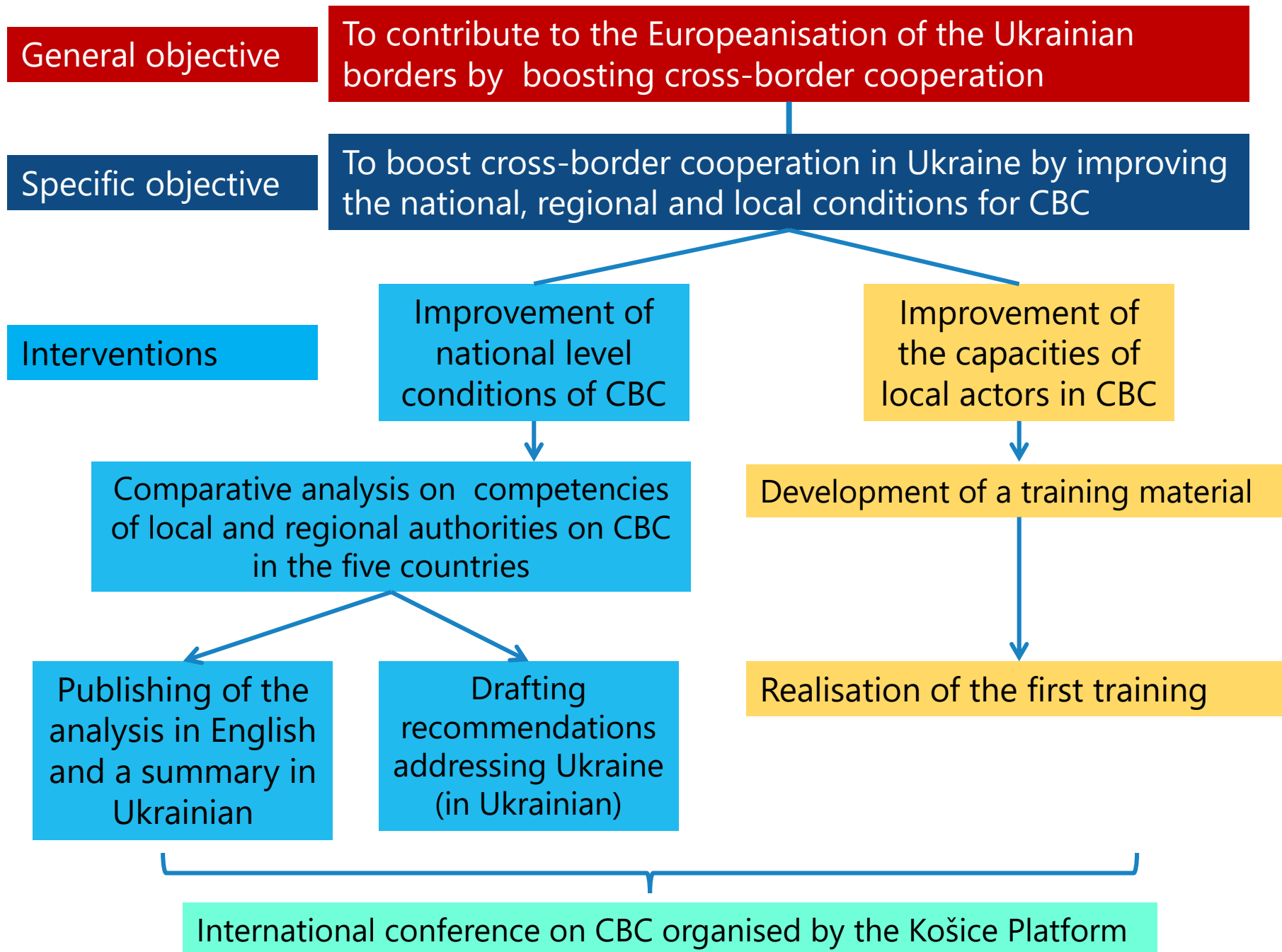
**General objective**
