

CROSS-BORDER COOPERATION – LEGAL FRAMEWORK

Spain/Portugal

Valencia Treaty (2002) - Spanish and Portuguese Treaty for CBC between territorial instances and entities

> Defines the **cooperation bodies, with legal personality** (Associations governed by public law + Consortium according to Spanish law) and **without legal personality** (Working Communities + Working groups)


Creates the **Spanish-Portuguese Committee on CBC** (intergovernmental body, responsible for supervision and evaluation of the Treaty + prepares annual bilateral high level political summit)

CBC Observatory GOALS?

- PICTURE OF THE EURO REGION privileged instrument for collection, systematization and analysis of pertinent information on the economic, social and territorial development of the Euro region;
- VISIBILITY dissemination of information and knowledge of the economic, social and territorial characteristics of the Euro region, the institutional and business environment, promoting more effective and dynamic cooperation;
- **IDENTIFICATION OF TRENDS reducing the uncertainty associated with economic activity**, enhancing in this way, the interregional flows of people, goods and services, capital and knowledge.

Without mutual knowledge, cooperation can't be sufficiently intense and fruitful. The challenge is to reduce information asymmetries on both sides of the border.

CROSS-BORDER COOPERATION - OP

Spain/Portugal 2007-2013

Budget: 267 M€ (FEDER) (PT 75%)

3 calls;

- 215 approved projects;
- 40% of the approval related to: Competitiveness and Employment
- 30% of the approval related to: Environment, Heritage and risks prevention;
- >1.000 entities as partner;
- >50% of approved projects are from Galicia/Norte PT + Norte PT/CyL area
- 8 projects with CCDRN
