During last 5 years I have researched and published mostly articles related to the cross-border co-operation As a first or single author I published 5 articles indexed in WoS/Scopus (4 of them with IF), and 8 chapters in book monographs. Their overview can be found on a next page

In 2015-2017 I was a member of the external experts’ group (co-ordinated by the European Commission, DG REGIO) trying to identify and remove administrative obstacles to the cross-border co-operation.

I believe that membership in this network brought a chance to become one of the contracted experts of the Association of European Border Regions (AEBR). Under their B-solutions initiative, I wrote two studies on removing administrative obstacles to the cross-border public services in autumn 2019 – one of them targeting possible cross-border healthcare provision for Czechs in Saxony, the other on constructing trilateral footbridge on German-Polish-Czech border.

Currently I am a member of the monitoring committee of the ongoing COST Action European Non-Territorial Autonomy Network, targeting also minorities in the CBC – [www.entan.org](http://www.entan.org).

In 2018 and 2019 I organised summer schools “Corss-border Co-operation in Central and Eastern Europe – Is It a Story of Sucess?” for Western Europe and the US students. see summerschool.tul.cz. I have got enough applications for 2020 edition, however it will have to be cancelled due to the current border-crossing regime.
