2.1 Decision on exclusion

Recently, it became necessary to take action regarding the membership fee arrears of two of our General Assembly members. The members concerned are the following (their name, the decision number of their election as members): 1) **Sajó-Rima Euroregion** - 6/2009. (XI. 12), 2) **Municipality of Nyíradony** - Decision No 37/2011 (V. 26.).

Despite of the verifiable written payment notices from the work organisation, the two members failed to pay the prescribed annual membership fees in the period 2024-2026, the payment of which is otherwise a member's obligation. The membership fee arrears are HUF 150 000 per member.

The dates and related events of the confirmable requests for payment of membership fees and arrears are as follows:

- 20/03/2024 = sending of the 2024 membership fee invoice;
- 28/02/2025 = sending the 2024 reminder and the 2025 invoice;
- 04/04/2025 = sending a reminder for all debts to date;
- 10/03/2026 = sending aggregated debt; the deadline for payment was 25.03.2026.
- We waited until the 15th of April for any payments to be made.

At no time did the representatives of the Members concerned formally react to the demands for payment.

According to the relevant paragraphs of the CESCI Statutes:

2.2(c), Obligation of the member:

"(c) The membership fee undertaken (the amount of which is set out in a resolution of the general meeting) shall be paid regularly. The membership fee shall be paid annually in advance, in a single amount, by 31 March of the current year at the latest. New members shall pay the membership fee, calculated pro rata for the remainder of the year of entry, within 15 days of the date of entry.'

Point 5.4:

'A member who regularly or persistently fails to fulfil his obligations or seriously impedes the operation of the association, or endangers the attainment of its objectives, or otherwise

behaves in a manner that makes membership of the association unworthy, may be excluded from the membership of the association.'

In view of the above, on 27 April the President of the Supervisory Board requested the President of the Association to initiate an exclusion procedure concerning the two members. On the basis of the initiative, the president asked the Board to carry out the necessary procedure.

The Board included the matter on the agenda of its meeting of 28 May 2026, and the two members received detailed information on the matter by registered letter from the head of the working organisation, including the possibility of presenting a defence, at the above-mentioned meeting.

The President will report orally to the General Assembly on the proposal of the Board on exclusion, as the Board meeting and the General Assembly will be held on the same day.

In the event of possible exclusion, the members concerned shall have access to a legal remedy within 30 days.

The proposal for a decision has been drafted in view of the unsuccessful consultation with the two members so far.

2.2 Acknowledgement of the resignation of a member

Our member, Miklós Kószó, thanking the Association for its trust to date, by virtue of his right guaranteed in point 5.2 of the Association's Articles of Association, announced that he resigns from his membership in the Association as of 31 December 2025, as he intends to enter into a permanent legal relationship with CESCI from the following year. He has no outstanding membership obligations or membership fee arrears.

In the future, our outgoing member will assist our association in a different way.

I would like to ask the General Assembly to take note of the resignation of our member Miklós Kószó.
