### **6. agenda: Amendments to the Procurement Policy**

Honourable Assembly!

The amendments to the CESCI Procurement Policy are set out in the annex to this proposal. The amendments aim to respond more effectively to the challenges posed by the expansion of the Association's procurement activities, simplify the rules, improve the transparency of procedures and clarify certain provisions. The main groups of amendments are as follows:

- clarification of the wording and alignment with the content (Sections II.3, VI.b, VI.1–3 and VII);
- expansion of the circle of decision-makers in the procedure, so that the Secretary-General may also be responsible for expert procurements related to his/her own field of responsibility (Sections VI.6.a–b);
- correction of a clerical error made in the previous amendment.

If the Honourable General Assembly agrees with the amendments, I kindly ask it to vote on both the amendments and the new consolidated text.
