Proposal for the CESCI General Assembly meeting to be held on 31 May 2021

4. agenda: Accession to international organisations (ISOCARP, EuRegha, RSA, TG-WeB)

As a result of previous negotiations, accession to several well-known international organisations would make the work of CESCI more efficient. The reasons of the accession of the organisations below are the following:

- 1) The *Regional Studies Association* is one of the most significant global networks, operating in the fields of regional and urban research, development and policy, whose financial and networking capacities would become available through the accession.
- 2) The *EUREGHA* professional network brings together the health authorities on European regional and local level, as well as those professional organisations that support crossborder health integration. Since our association has been engaging in extensive activities in this field over the past few years, accession to the organisation would greatly facilitate the efficiency of our cross-border health cooperation efforts.
- 3) The *ISOCARP* is an international network created especially for urban and land developers, its professional importance is globally significant in the topic. Through this accession, the development expertise of CESCI can further be deepened, and our professional network would significantly increase.
- 4) The Western Balkans Network on Territorial Governance, initiated by the Spatial Foresight, is a more informal professional association, created with the goal of facilitating the European integration of the region, especially in the field of territorial governance. This is clearly in accordance with the objectives of CESCI, our professional goals seem more accessible as a part of this network. The accession is free of charge.

The applicable annual membership fees, which shall be financed by the budget of CESCI, are the following:
