In military terminology, the code '4.5.0.' signifies "ALL IS QUIET".

This name conveys the fundamental reassurance that individuals in need of help and medical intervention seek to hear - "RELAX - EVERYTHING WILL BE FINE!"



The number "5" is depicted as an upward arrow, symbolizing that at the center, visitors are assisted in "rising," solving problems, feeling uplifted, and experiencing growth in strength and possibilities.



The number "O" is associated with a survey icon, signifying that each center visitor has their own history, unique characteristics, medical aspects, preferences, wishes, and possibly certain taboos. It's a questionnaire where all individual aspects of each visitor are taken into account. Unlike a hospital where the focus is solely on diagnoses and their solutions, we prioritize people! Their stories, perspectives, and thoughts matter.

A center for comprehensive health restoration, psychological well-being, and further self-realization of military personnel and individuals affected by war.

It is the only center of this kind in the Transcarpathian region.

We feature an operating ADC (Administrative Services Center).

Cardiorespiratory pathologies.


Our goal

Located in the area of Ukraine most remote from active combat zones, resulting in fewer air raid alerts and, consequently, lower levels of anxiety regarding personal safety and triggering factors.

Is based in the recreational region with robust recovery opportunities: in close proximity to balneological centers with thermal and mineral waters, mountain air, and locations for mental restoration such as ski resorts, fishing spots, rafting, etc.


Is neighboring European countries, which provides a quick exchange of specialists, the possibility of gaining experience from European model medical centers, and participation in European rehabilitation programs.

Can cooperate with a large number of local and relocated businesses within Transcarpathia willing to provide employment opportunities and training facilities for skill development.

The Center is based on in-depth research into the psychology of military personnel regarding their interaction with medical institutions.

While creating the 4.5.0. recovery center, the issues related to the interaction of military personnel with medical institutions were thoroughly investigated. The surveys were conducted in focus groups, the queries were analyzed, and the problematic situations encountered by military personnel in other medical facilities were scrutinized. Thus, the overall concept of the Center was shaped based on the real experiences of military personnel and their families.

Integration of the center's capabilities with the recreational opportunities of Transcarpathia.


Provision of psychoemotional support to veterans by the functioning of veteran hubs directly at the Center's location.

THE ADVANTAGES OF THE CENTER ARE:



A visual concept of the Center, which is a building resembling more of a counseling and support center than a hospital, as well as a non-intimidating interior, hostesses at the entrance, symbolic gifts to each individual upon completion of treatment, etc.

Addressing one of the important issues for the wounded (according to feedback and research), which is the availability of outdoor recreation space near the center and proximity to recreational areas and various leisure bases where the individuals can change the scenery and distract themselves from the healing process during the post-acute rehabilitation period.

The availability of space within the center for organizing diverse events and quality leisure. Sometimes recovery can be lengthy, and thus, people can spend their time engagingly, distracting themselves, and breaking the routine with events.

Rehabilitated patients or family members of military personnel, if they wish, will have the opportunity to be employed at the **«4.5.0. recovery center»**.










