# The context: legal accessibility projects

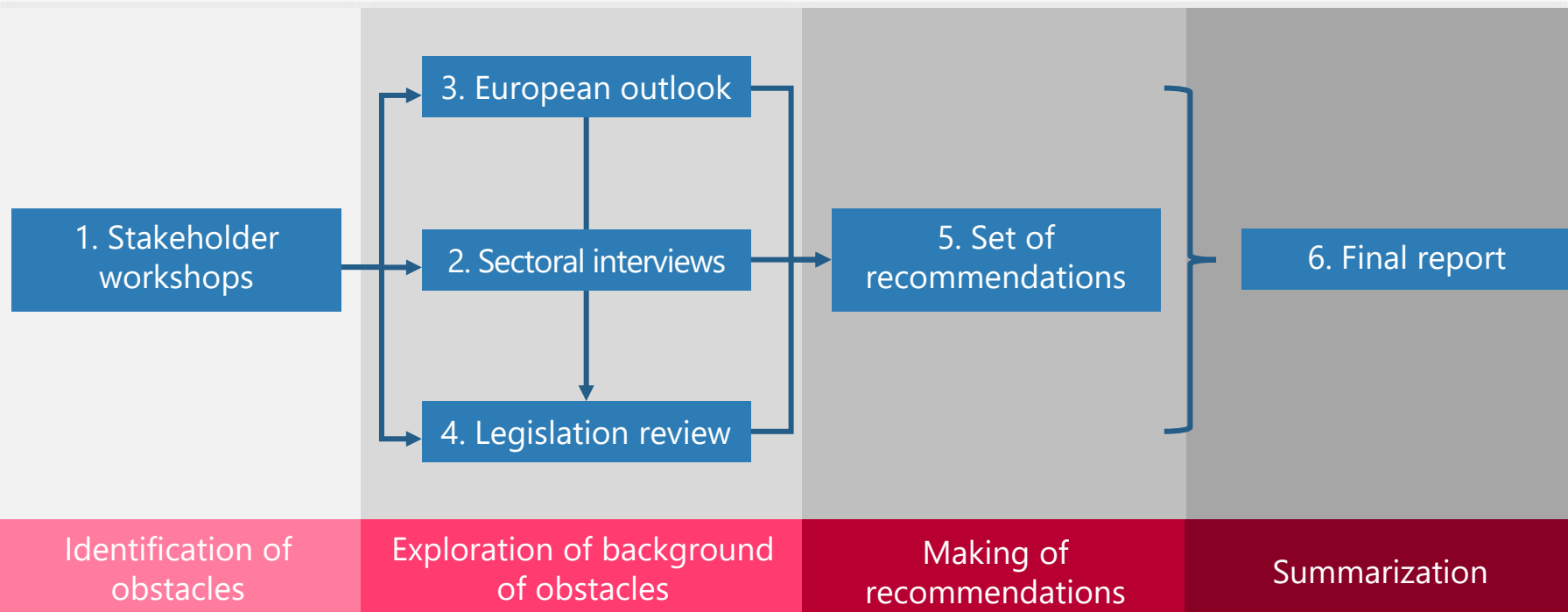
**2014/2015:** Unsuccessful project proposal (DG JUSTICE)

**2015:** The Cross-Border Review project (DG REGIO) + ECBM WG

**2017:** Communication *'Boosting Growth and Cohesion of EU Border Regions'*

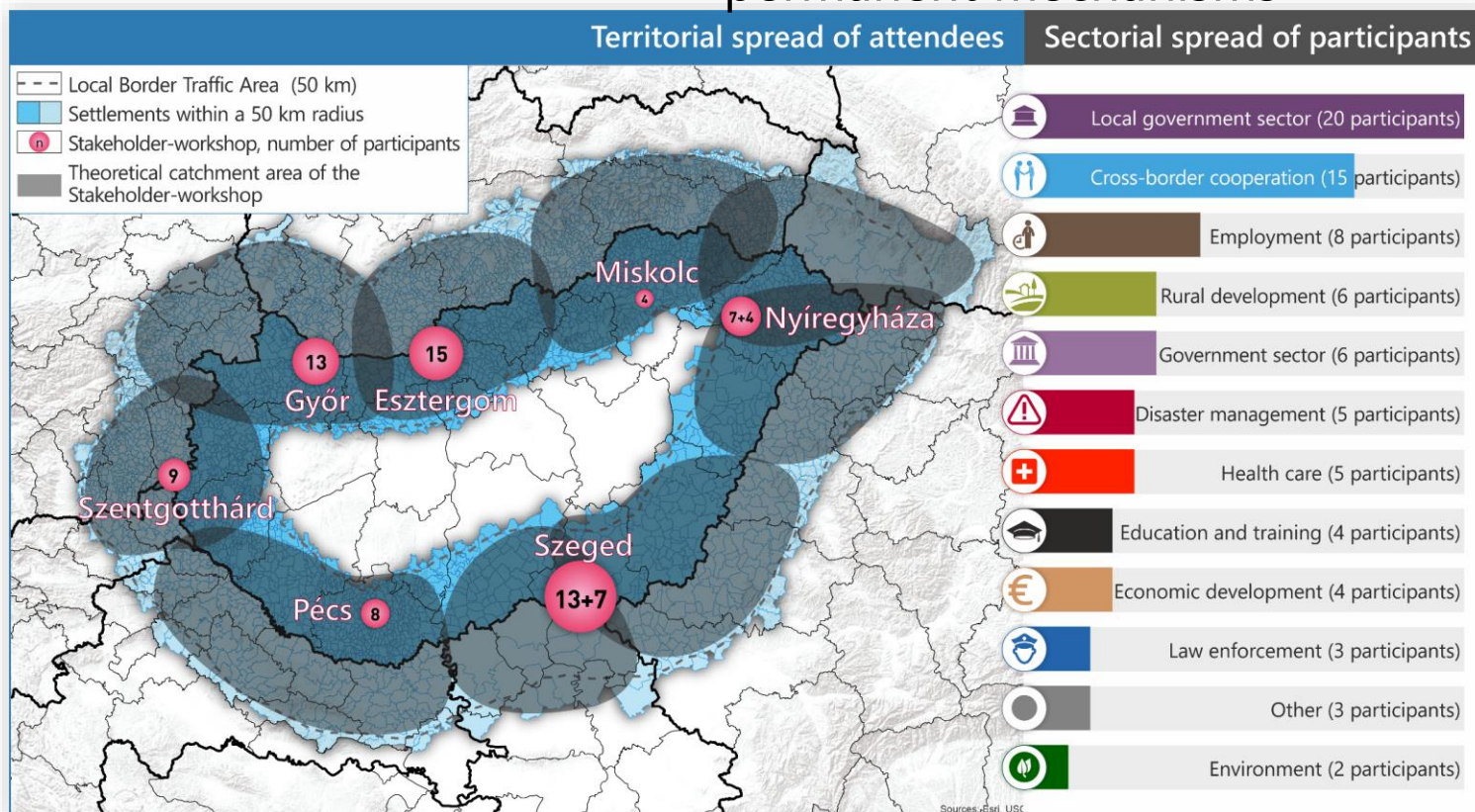
**2018:** Border Focal Point + B-Solutions initiative

**2016:** Legal Accessibility PILOT project



# The context: legal accessibility projects

- Analysis of nearly 250 legal acts
- 57 obstacles, 68 interviews, 52 good examples, 39 concrete policy or legal recommendations
- 2 horizontal recommendations: access to information + permanent mechanisms



## The context: legal accessibility projects

### **2016-2021:** Legal Accessibility projects (6 milestones)

- Cross-border health services
- Cross-border retail of local products
- Cross-border public procurement
- EGTC rules
- Legal solutions supporting the integration of cross-border urban agglomerations (French model)
- Legal aspects of the national COVID measures
- Integration of information services on legal accessibility across national borders
- Legal Accessibility between the Visegrad countries

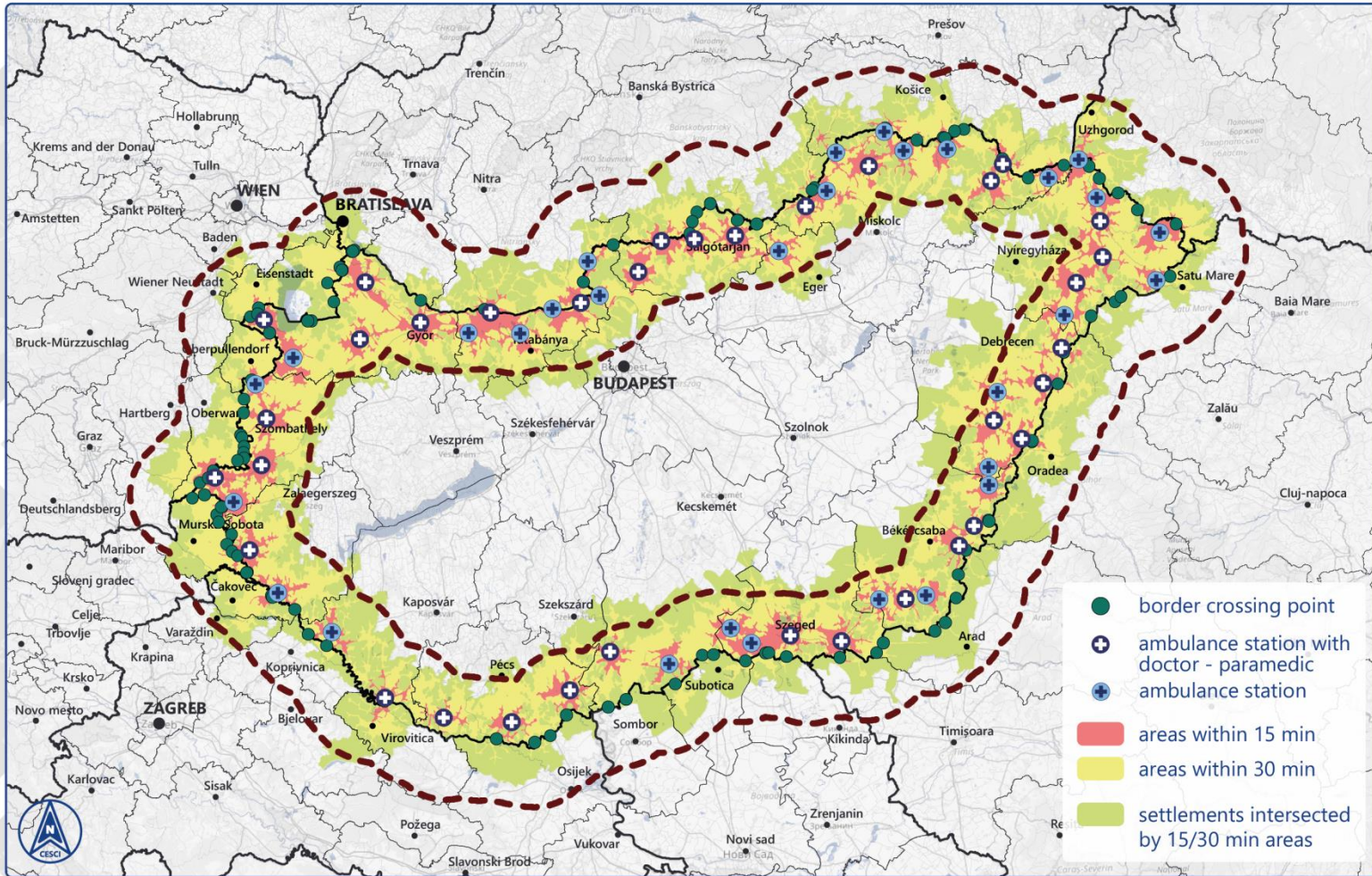

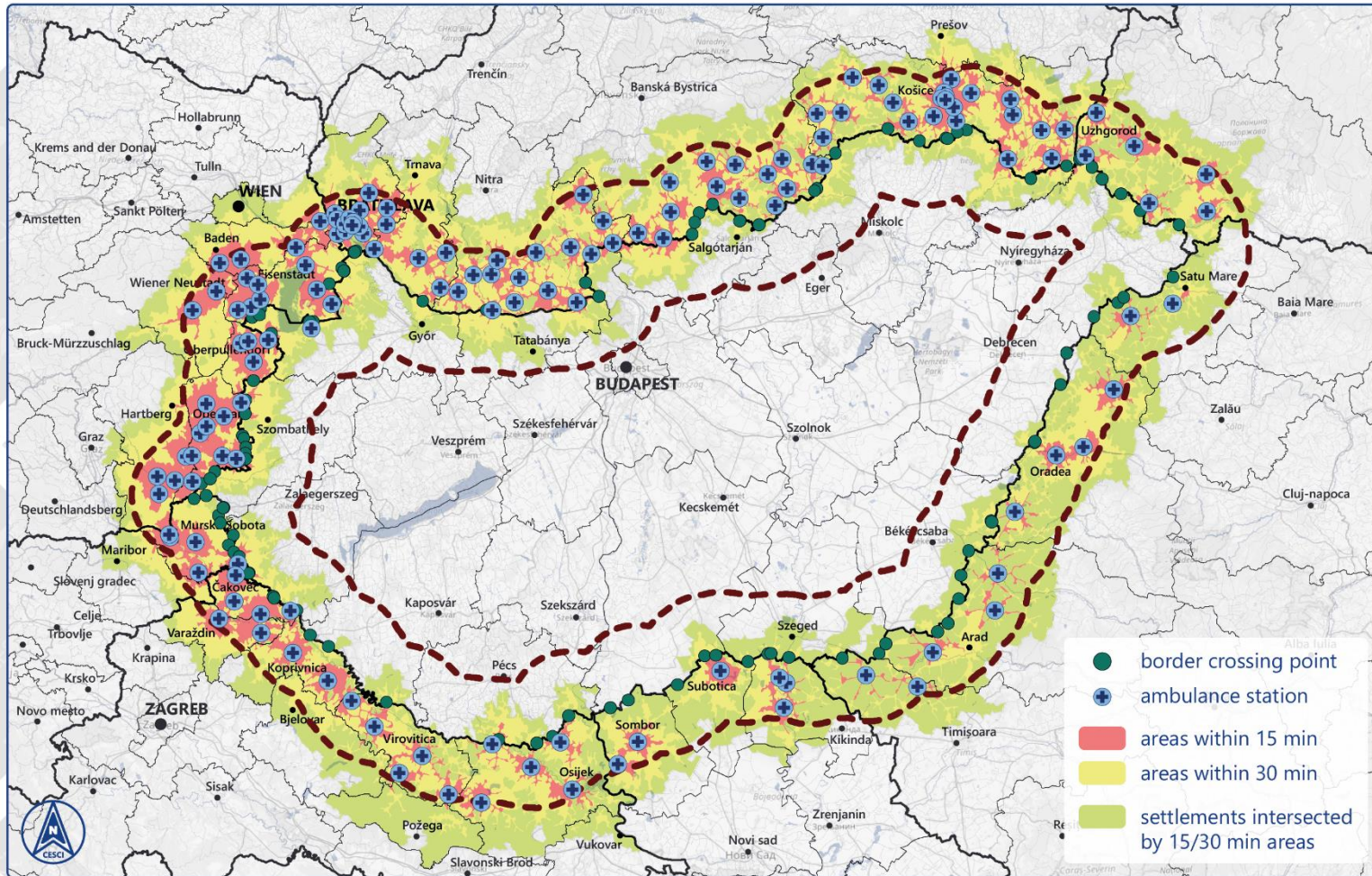

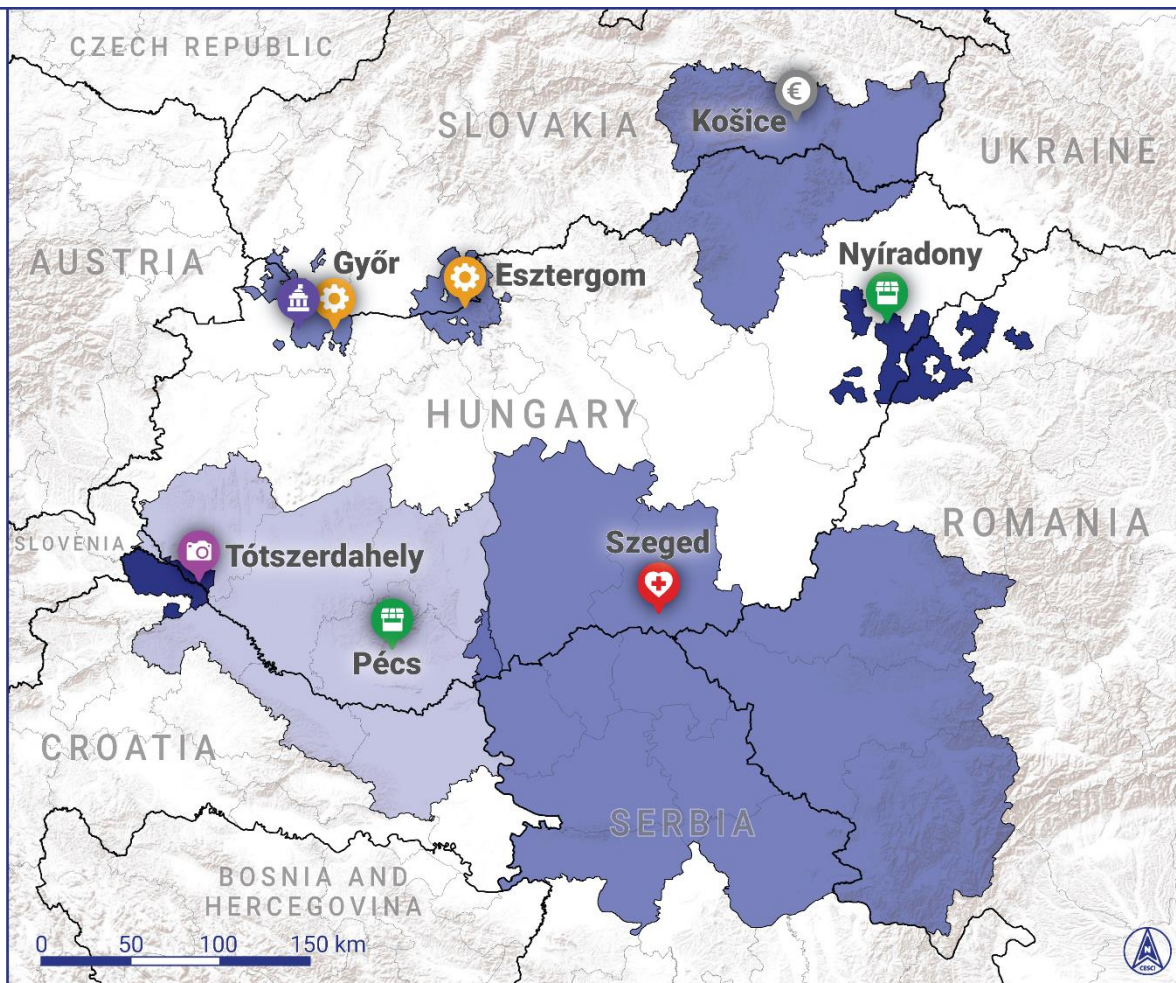
